SAILING COURSES

RYA National Sailing Scheme Level 1 and 2 (4-day course)

This course is for complete beginners who want to learn how to sail through the RYA syllabus. Depending on your progression, this four-day course will give you the capability and confidence to take a sailing dinghy out without an instructor in light winds. An RYA certificate will be issued. No sailing experience necessary.

Tuesday 26th March	to	Friday 29th March	(09:00 - 16:30)
Tuesday 28th May	to	Friday 31st May	(09:00 - 16:30)
Monday 05th August	to	Thursday 08th August	(09:00 - 16:30)

Cost: Club Members £250.00 (£210.00 for 14-17 year olds). Non-members £450.00. These courses include use of club boats, buoyancy aids and RYA NSS Logbook (G4) and RYA Start Sailing (G3) textbook.

RYA Youth Sailing Scheme Stages 1 to 4 (3-day courses)

Stages 1 & 2 'Introduction and Basics' are suitable for beginners.

Stages 3 & 4 'Improvers' are designed to develop single and double handed helming and crewing skills building on Stages 1 & 2. Progression through the stages will depend on aptitude and experience.

Stages 1 – 2 : Tuesday 28th May to Thursday 30th May	(9:00 - 16:30)
Stages 1 – 2: Monday 05th August to Wednesday 07th August	(9:00 - 16:30)
Stages 3 – 4: Monday 05th August to Wednesday 07th August	(9:00 - 16:30)

Note that a Stage 2 certificate is a prerequisite for entry onto the Stages 3 and 4 Course. **Cost:** Members £150.00: Non club members £250.00. These courses include use of club boats and buoyancy aids and RYA YSS Logbook (G11). Minimum age 7 years.

RYA Start Racing - an introduction to racing (2 days)
RYA Assistant Instructor - centre-specific instructor qualification (2 days)

RYA Dinghy Instructor - internationally recognised instructor qualification (5 days)

POWERBOAT COURSES

RYA Powerboat Level 1 and 2 (2-day course)

This course provides the skills and background knowledge needed by the competent powerboat driver and is the basis of the International Certificate of Competence.

Saturday 09th ar	nd Saturday 16th Novembe	er (09:00 – 16:30)

RYA Safetyboat (2-day course)

This course provides the skills required when acting as an escort craft, safety boat or coach boat for a fleet of dinghies, windsurfers or canoes and for racing or training activities.

Sunday 11th and Saturday 18th February	(08:00 - 16:30)
Sunday 10th and Sunday 17th November	(08:00 - 16:30)

Cost: Club Members £100.00. Non club members £300.00. These courses include use of club boats, buoyancy aids and RYA Powerboat Logbook (G20).

Note: Members who would like training in relation to club safetyboat duties should liaise with their class captain.

SATURDAY ADULT CLUB

Fun sailing for members and non-members wanting to improve their sailing skills and confidence, also an opportunity for non-sailors to try sailing. Most Saturday mornings from 6th April until October. Booking in advance essential. Sessions will be run by RYA instructors.

Cost: £10.00 for the half day or £30.00 if you book individual tuition (with an instructor). Boats are available for those who do not have their own boats, at a maximum charge of £15.00 per half day. No RYA qualifications are awarded.
